The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00hrs** on **04/03/2025.** No telephonic, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "8/3/1-6/2024: "CONSTRUCTION OF LEBOHANG STADIUM IN LEANDRA" with "NAME of TENDERER" must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box provided at the reception area, Govan Mbeki Municipality main building, Secunda CBD by no later than 12h00 on 04/03/2025. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby work will be allocated to successful bidders in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Govan Mbeki Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respective of price and 20 points for a specific goal on a competitive basis for successful bidders on this tender. Govan Mbeki Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy allocate 20 points to race (6), people with disability (4), youth (4), woman (4) and Implementing reconstruction and development programme (2).

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder, or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

NB: Only locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered in line with Regulation 8(2) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations and National Treasury Circular 69."

The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South-African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid; and Only the South-African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 12863:2011 must be used to calculate local content.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to readvertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Bidders that do not hear anything after three (3) from closing date of this tender, must consider their bids to be unsuccessful.
